Players

1. Play by the rules
 2. Never argue with an official
 3. Control your temper
 4. Work hard to benefit your team's performance
 5. Be a good sport. Applaud good performances made by your team and the opposition
 6. Treat other participants as you would like to be treated
 7. Co-operate with your coach, team mates, officials and opponents
 8. Respect the rights of all other participants
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Spectators

1. Remember that participants play for their enjoyment, not yours
 2. Focus on participants' efforts and performance rather than winning or losing
 3. Encourage participants to play by the rules
 4. Applaud good performance by all participants
 5. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sport
 6. Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, official and administrators
 7. Respect referees' decisions
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Officials

1. Place the safety and welfare of participants above all else
 2. Accept responsibility for your actions
 3. Be impartial
 4. Avoid situations that may lead to a conflict of interest
 5. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion
 6. Seek continual self-improvement
 7. Be a positive role model
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Coaches

1. Respect the rights and dignity of others
 2. Ensure time spent with you is a positive experience for your players
 3. Treat each player as an individual
 4. Be fair, honest and considerate
 5. Operate within the rules and spirit of Touch
 6. Avoid unnecessary or inappropriate physical contact
 7. Be a positive role model
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
