## **10.0 Auditor**

It was resolved that Ian Krarup (Aspire Taxation & Accounting) be appointed as Auditor of the Association for the current year. Due to changing rules it was resolved that a full audit be performed this year. (Scott Carpenter to action).

## **11.0 General Business**

### **11.1 Referees**

The Referees Coordinator was requested to ensure greater variety in the allocation of referees to teams throughout the season. This was to be aided by the current pool of referees advising if they did the same team too often.

Consensus was that the competition is expanding faster than the pool of referees. Referee Coordinator will trial sending out email expecting people to turn up, rather than allocating. Expectation is for referees not attending to notify via SMS. Furthermore we will be looking for teams to provide a duty referee on a roster system. (Chris Kelly to send out via email for new season)

Referee fees are to be increased to \$15.00 for a buddy and \$20.00 for a single game.

The option for referees to be paid monthly was accepted. Referees are to advise the Referees Coordinator if this is their preferred form of payment.

### **11.2 Insurance**

Since we affiliated with City Touch we have had access to Insurance with Qld Sports Management. This has resulted in a saving of over 50% from our previous insurance premium. Current fees are approx \$2,000.00 with the same level of cover as previously.

### **11.3 Competition Expansion**

Last season we had 26 teams for the summer competition which resulted in 2 teams having a bye each week as our capacity is 24. Should we have 28 teams which is possible, the competition will go to 4 time slots 6.00 pm, 6.50, 7.40, 8.30. Referees will need to be rotated as doing 4 games will be too onerous. Other options were looked at to increase field numbers, such as hiring additional lights but at \$250.00 per night are too costly and impractical. The Association to keep in contact with school as the old grandstand may be replaced, which could provide additional lights on the adjacent field.

## **11.4 General Business**

- In the event of games being washed out a more practical and cost effective way to notify majority of players is via SMS. Scott and Chris to set system up and source a service provider.
- Teams shirts to have numbers at least 16 cm high as per rules. Chris to advise teams via email.
- Association is to develop a Logo (Chris Kelly, Ash Price, Matt Carey to action)
- Current protocol is to supply trophies for premiers and runners up. Association to investigate other options such as caps, shirts or flash drives as alternatives, dependent on a logo being developed first.
- Scott Carpenter to update templates on the Web site.

# **President's Report**

## **Another Great Year**

Following our hugely successful 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary year in 2007 it is pleasing to see that we have maintained our momentum on every measure from Fair Play ratings to number of participants to financials. Special thanks are due to our dedicated committee members and of course our trusty troupe of referees.

## **Donations**

The Association continued its tradition of philanthropy, giving \$250 to each of the Victorian bushfire and North Queensland flood appeals.

## **New Logo**

As the front cover of this report reveals, the Association finally has a new logo. A competition was run on the website [www.99designs.com](http://www.99designs.com) and over 40 designs were created. Five excellent entries made the shortlist before the winning design was chosen by a members' poll. It has already been incorporated into our letterhead, stationery and trophies and will be added to clothing, footballs and the website in due course. We have also applied to trademark the logo.

## **Wiki**

A wiki site has been developed and is available (to committee members only) at [bcta.wikidot.com](http://bcta.wikidot.com). It provides a comprehensive repository of information the Association relies upon to operate effectively, and which was hitherto only stored in the committee member's heads.

## **SMS Service**

We have introduced an SMS service to quickly advise players whenever games are washed out. It currently has a total of 96 subscribers. Our email list has grown to 207 subscribers.

## **Facebook**

The Association now has its own Facebook group at [www.facebook.com](http://www.facebook.com), currently with 43 members. We've had hundreds (if not thousands) of players over our 22 year history, so please invite current and past players to join!

## **Queensland Touch League**

Like a number of other touch competitions unsatisfied with formal affiliation options, the BCTA is now an associate of the *Queensland Touch League* ([qtl.qsmsports.com](http://qtl.qsmsports.com)). It is not an affiliation in any sense since the QTL is not a formal body, but rather just a vehicle to further communication and cooperation between different associations and gain economies of scale for the likes of insurance and referee training.

## **Casuarina Cup**

Two BCTA teams took part in the *Casuarina Cup* touch tournament at northern NSW in February 2009. Luckily there was no repeat of the 40 degree weather endured last year, though a Friday afternoon thunderstorm caused some disruption. *Half Full* had the more success, making it to the semi finals of the social mixed division before going down to the eventual winners 4-3. *Ghosties* won two of their four pool games and were unlucky to miss out on the semis on for-and-against. Thanks to QTL who did a great job at organising

accommodation at the brand new Cotton Beach resort. The Saturday night BBQ at Kingscliffe Surf Club was apparently a highlight. The BCTA subsidised 50% of our teams' nomination fees and we look forward to more BCTA teams participating in such tournaments in the future.

### **Winter Competition Review**

Our 2008 winter comp saw a record 25 nominations, up from the previous record of 22 in 2007. Incredibly, the grand finals in all four mixed grades were decided by a margin of just one touchdown yet there were no drop-offs (though two games were decided by touchdowns right on the fulltime hooter). Mixed C grade deserves a special mention as the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> ranked teams, *Half Full* and *Touch Me*, knocked out their higher seeded opponents to meet in the grand final. Full details can of course be found in our results section.

### **Summer Competition review**

The 2008/09 summer comp also had 25 teams and was the strongest comp we have run for many years. The winter comp A grade premiers *Pretty* could "only" win B grade, while the winter B grade grand finalists *Latecomers* and *Ruck It* both found themselves in C grade. *Next Link* defied the trend by recruiting well and improving from D grade to A grade runners-up!

### **Uniform Subsidy**

Our \$150 uniform subsidy continues to be a success with virtually all teams now correctly (and in many cases impressively) outfitted. Combined with the 15% discount BCTA teams receive through our preferred supplier *Culdee Clothing* ([www.culdee.com.au](http://www.culdee.com.au)) they make uniforms very affordable at around \$200 per set of 12. Six teams already have taken advantage of it.

### **A Chaplain at Last**

I am delighted to report that the position of Chaplain, regrettably vacant since 2004, has been filled by Phil Eagling. Phil is the Youth Pastor at Sunnybank Baptist and a former BCTA member, perhaps more years ago than he would care to admit. We look forward to his guidance and other contributions to the Association.

## Team Numbers

The 2008/09 season has seen a continued increase in numbers, with both the winter and Summer season having record numbers of teams (25 each). The competition in all 4 grades has been very close throughout the year, making for successful seasons. Congratulations to all the winners, and also the other teams that have participated. It is with pleasure that I can report, we have had a high standard of behaviour with very few send-offs or other on field indiscretions. Thank you to everyone involved in making this year one of our most successful ever.

## Playing Fields

We have now been playing at Tennyson for 13 years. Whilst we had concerns in 2007 with regard to the drought, the 2008/09 year has seen a return to a wet weather pattern. Unfortunately we did have to call off a few nights this year due to rain; however the upside has been that the fields have been in top condition throughout the entire year. As I have noted previously we need to continue to be mindful that we are at one of Brisbane's best sporting venues. Please keep this in mind, ensuring the fields are left in a clean state when we leave, and by keeping noise to a minimum as we drive away.

## Finance

A full set of figures appears in the Treasurer's report. It is pleasing to advise the Association is in a healthy financial position. We will continue to be diligent in controlling costs where possible. An example of this was our association with QTL. The result was that we were able to access their insurance thus saving the association a couple of thousand dollars per year on premiums. We will also continue to ensure our fees are kept as low as possible.

## Barbeque

We have held 4 barbecues throughout the year. It is unfortunate that it always seems to be a precursor for rain. For both of the previous barbecues rain has fallen causing an early end to the night and creating a programming problem for Chris as we try to reschedule games. On the positive side it brings us all together in and we can laugh and share in a meal.

A big thank you to the Hapts, for generously giving their time, doing the organising and cooking on the night. We will continue to holding this function especially when the fields need some rain. The night will be announced on the web site and notice board.

## **Uniforms**

Last year the Association established an agreement with “Cudlee Clothing” to receive a 15% discount, and we would contribute to the cost thus making the cost of new uniforms very affordable. (Approx \$200.00 for set 12). It is pleasing to note that many teams have taken up the offer and now all teams add to the professionalism of the competition. Please note also it helps referee’s having everyone in the correct colours with clearly legible numbers.

## **Summary**

I can confidently state that the 2008/09 Winter Summer season has been one of our best. We have had record numbers of teams participating, very close competition, well behaved players, and referee’s for every game. To all the other committee members, well done! Together we all contribute to have a very successful competition. The key to this success is that everyone is willing to chip in utilising our various talents. A big thanks also goes to St Joseph’s college for permitting our continued use of the fields.
