## **12.0 General Business**

### **12.0 General Business**

#### **12.1 Winter Season 2013**

We will have 19 teams which is four less than the Summer Competition. Six teams are not returning while two are joining. Ten have nominated for six-a-side (A, B and C grades) and nine D grade (seven-a-side).

#### **12.2 Referee Training**

Referee training is still needed, as are interpretations guidelines.

#### **12.3 Drop-Off Rule**

Revised drop off rule as per previous season to be implemented in semi-finals and grand finals as required. Teams will drop two players until a result is achieved.

#### **12.4 Schools Carnival**

The BCTA ran the *Brisbane Christian Schools* touch carnival for the second year. It was held at Whites Hill touch fields on Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> April 2012 and attracted 40 teams, a big increase on the 21 teams at the 2011 carnival. Chris Kelly was again the tournament director. With a further increase in nominations anticipated in 2013 a larger venue such as Tennyson or Villanova fields will be considered.

#### **12.5 BCTA Carnival**

BCTA will be holding a carnival in July at our Tennyson venue.

#### **12.6 Six-a-Side Competition**

Consideration needs to be given to moving all grades to a six-a-side format, which is the norm at most other competitions and particularly for juniors. Chris Kelly will survey our existing members at the end of winter season with a view to making changes for the 2012/13 summer season. One possibility is moving to a two division format with

Division 1 being six-a-side (A & B grades) while Division 2 remains seven-a-side (C & D grades).

Outcome will be what members want.

**12.7 Locker**

The old locker was extensively damaged in the flood and now that we are back at Tennyson a new one is required. Col Roome to purchase. Chris Kelly will purchase padlocks for same.

**12.8 Table**

A new table is required for displaying match cards, information, first aid supplies, etc. Col Roome to purchase.

**12.9 Referees**

It was again noted that most of the refereeing load is shouldered by a comparatively few referees. To alleviate some of the load it has been suggested that teams that provide a referee could receive a discount \$50.00 of their registration fees.

### E Grade, 6-a-Side

Summer 2013/14 saw the introduction of an E grade competition, with all grades now operating under 6-a-side rules. Feedback from players on both counts has been positive. Moving to entirely 6-a-side has certainly been the right decision and indeed might have happened a bit earlier but for the 2011 flood disruption.

### Additional Field Lights

Work is being undertaken on the main oval and it will include floodlighting for two additional touch fields. It is expected to be complete by July 2014. This represents an expansion opportunity for us in the 2014/15 summer comp.

### NRL / Touch Alliance

In August 2013 a strategic alliance between the National Rugby League and Touch Football Australia was announced. While details are still emerging, it may result in making affiliation a more attractive option. We will continue to monitor developments. [LINK](#)

### BCTA Mixed Touch Carnival

2012 carnival was twice abandoned due to rain. 2013 proved luckier and we ran a successful carnival in October attracting 12 teams (including 4 from the BCTA) across two divisions. Congratulations to the 2 *Fresh* club which took out both the competitive and social divisions. For the first time both divisions were 6-a-side.

### Schools Carnival

We again ran the Brisbane Christian Schools touch carnival in 2013, this time at the Tennyson fields. The event was again very successful with 38 teams across 4 divisions.

**State Youth Games**

We will be providing referees for the touch competition at the 2014 State Youth Games at Caboolture in June. Hopefully this will attract some teams to our regular competition. [LINK](#)

## *Secretary's Report*

The 2013 -14 season has run very smoothly with no interruptions to the competition. The weather has generally been kind with only a few nights washed out. The summer competition had a great run with next to no rain, therefore finishing for the first time in many years on the first week in March. We now look forward to the commencement of the 2014 Winter Season on the 29th April.

This season the decision was made to have an all six a side competition. Whilst there were a few members hesitant to make the change, the move has been generally accepted and good competition exists between teams in the same grades. I would like to congratulate the 5 team winners for the summer competition being: A grade: Bullet Proof, B grade: Second Wind, C grade: Sliders, D grade: FLATT and E grade: Touch of Peace. Likewise congratulations also go to our winter winners being Bullet Proof, Split Ends, Peptides and Sliders.

This now is the first full year that the BCTA has been back at the fields at Tennyson. Whilst the numbers of teams participating (19 in winter and 20 in summer) has not been quite as high as we would have liked, the committee understands that a period of rebuilding is taking place after the two and half years of disruption caused by the floods. This year we have as mentioned gone to an all six a side competition, regularly held barbecue nights, held a touch carnival on the 5 October with 12 teams participating. Further continuing actions has been promoting the competition through the school network via a large email contact list, encouraging through the competition members to bring in friends and new teams, keeping our fees at very competitive rates and offering discount for student teams.

With these actions we hopefully will get back to the numbers similar to prior to the floods and then with the addition of floodlights for two more fields happening mid 2014 continue to expand. Thanks all the committee members. Together we all contribute and especially this year we have worked hard to have a very successful competition. The key to this success is that everyone is willing to chip in utilising our various talents. The committee will continue work hard to promote the competition, reinforcing that we are playing on some of the best playing fields in Brisbane, with the aim of growing Christ's kingdom.

## *Referee Coordinator's Report*

The winter 2013 and summer 2013-13 seasons have not produced any significant changes in the depth and breadth of the team of referees available to the BCTA. Player-referees are still being sought as a valuable commodity for the Association, as this will hopefully improve both the availability and consistency of referees at the competition. The tracking of referees to teams has continued, and has largely been effective at reducing the problem of teams and referees growing tired of seeing each other week after week, and allowing conflicts and differences to fester and grow to unfriendly levels. The standard of refereeing is currently as high as I can remember it being, and will hopefully continue to improve as it becomes more of a focus.

Future seasons at the BCTA will continue to recruit within the pool of players in the competition, as well as the development and improvement of our overall refereeing standard. A clarification of variations in rules between our competition (Touch Football Australia) and other competitions such as CityTouch and Premier Touch etc. is soon to be drafted. This document will be helpful for referees and players alike, and I will endeavour to have this completed prior to the beginning of the winter 2014 season. I will also investigate the possibility of having assessments done (either by TFA or QSM affiliated referees) as well as external sources for coaching. Dan Gramshaw will continue to be engaged in a coaching role for our current referees. Katie Stone (Second Wind) has been a new addition to our referee team in the last season, and has benefited from the experience of our senior referees such as Dan and Ashley Price. James Freudigmann has been contacted and is willing to assist with refereeing in the coming seasons, which will be a valuable inclusion to our pool of referees also.

The refereeing fees for the winter season ran out to \$4803, and the recently finished summer 2013-14 season amounted to \$5274. It should be noted that the summer season included an extra game per round from Round 11 onwards. As usual, it would be preferred to have two referees per game during the regular season, and three referees per game during the finals. This has been the case for some time now, and seems to work well. The assignment of referees to individual teams is now being tracked and, barring a few exceptions, has resulted in a more even distribution across the competition.

In conclusion, I am very pleased with the current team of referees and their conduct. We will always be looking for improvements, particularly in the available pool of referees and also their experience. This will be a vital part of any expansion of the competition.

- A mid-season survey that could be used to collect some valuable information from team captains about the makeup of their teams (i.e. whether their player are already involved in Christian groups or not, which churches or groups their team is from, etc) and other valuable information.
- A letter to church or Christian based team captains alerting them to the ability to use of our touch football competition as an evangelistic opportunity to invite their non-Christian friends and work colleagues along to as well.
- A "bi-weekly" player profile that could be sent out with the draw asking a few brief questions to some of our Christian players that could include a question like "Who is Jesus to you?" or something like that amongst other normal profiling questions.
